Cultivation recommendations:

Recommended sowing rate	25 kg/ha
Sowing depth	2 - 4 cm
Sowing period	Early March until late May
Fertilization	Usually no fertilization required.
Crop protection	Usually there is no crop protection required
Sowing method	Drill sowing ensure high crop emergences
